The Karen Education Department is a non-profit organization supported by international charities & foundations that provides education in refugee camps along the Thai-Burma border and conflict areas inside Karen State, Burma. We invite foreign professionals and university students to participate as volunteers in development projects in different areas such as education, capacity building, community development, rural development and human rights.

Our mission is to assist the sustainable development of conflict affected communities and individuals within Karen State by providing education and complementary aid, and fortifying existing and future collaborative partners in providing (community) development services.

Unlike many other organizations, **the KED does not charge a program fee**. Placements are unpaid and volunteers have to cover travel, accommodation, visa and personal insurance costs. Positions, however, do provide accommodation and local transport costs when traveling for the KED.
